

MIKE ASHEY PRODUCTIONS PRESENTS ACRYLIC SHIP MODEL DISPLAY CASES

For years I built my own ship model display cases and each one took about 8 hours to make. The Plexiglas sheeting is also somewhat expensive and you need a table saw to cut all the pieces, sand the edges smooth and then glue it together.

I purchased an Acrylic display case from **SPECIALTY PLASTICS** located in Hamilton, Ohio as their price was less then what I could build it for not counting my time. I was very impressed with their workmanship and the case was well packaged to prevent damage during shipping. The edges are curved which is a nice touch and there are no noticeable glue marks along the seam areas.

The display case for the 1/350 scale Essex class aircraft carrier used for this review measures 35 inches long by 10 inches high and 8 inches deep and the cost was \$134 plus a nominal shipping charge. The case also included a base. Click "acrylic display boxes" on the left side of their website main page. At the top of this new page you will see "CUSTOM BOX CONFIGURATOR", which allows you to input the size you need and it also calculates the cost. Print the results and then call them with the order (800-582-9038).
