KIT DESCRIPTION AND BUILDING NOTES

The model depicts a Bf 110E flown by Lt. Felix-Maria Brandis as it appeared on the Eastern Front in 1942. It is finished in standard Luftwaffe camouflage of RLM 76/74/75.

The kit is very well detailed and it includes canopy masks, prepainted photoetch and decals for several different Luftwaffe units. Although the kit has some challenges it can be built into a fine replica. The kit has a lot of parts and some experience is recommended before you tackle this fine kit. The landing gear are particularly fiddly and great care must be exercised when removing the canopy parts from their trees as the parts are thin and delicate.

The kit was built straight from the box with the exception of crew figures from the Monogram Bf 110 kit. It was painted with an Iwata SB Micron airbrush using Testors model master enamel paint for the RLM 76 and Gunze Sangyo for the RLM 74/75. The exhaust stains were airbrushed using Tamiya smoke.
