AND BUILDING NOTES

This Revell kit was built long before there were resin and prepainted photoetch detail sets. The cockpit was scratchbuilt and Waldron Products instrument dials and placards were used. The seat belt buckles are from Model Technologies. The land gear wells were scratchbuilt, the doors were detailed and the landing gear modified. The elevator and rudder were removed and reattached as well as the flaps. The raised panel lines and rivet detail were sanded off and the lines rescribed with a Bare Metal Foil plastic scriber. The engine was reworked and wired and new push rods were added. The model is painted with Testors model master enamel paints. The books titled "Detailing Scale Model Aircraft" and "Model Aircraft Tips and Techniques", which are located in the book section of this web site, document how I scratchbuilt the cockpit and the landing gear wells, scribed the panel lines and removed and reattached the control surfaces and the flaps.
