

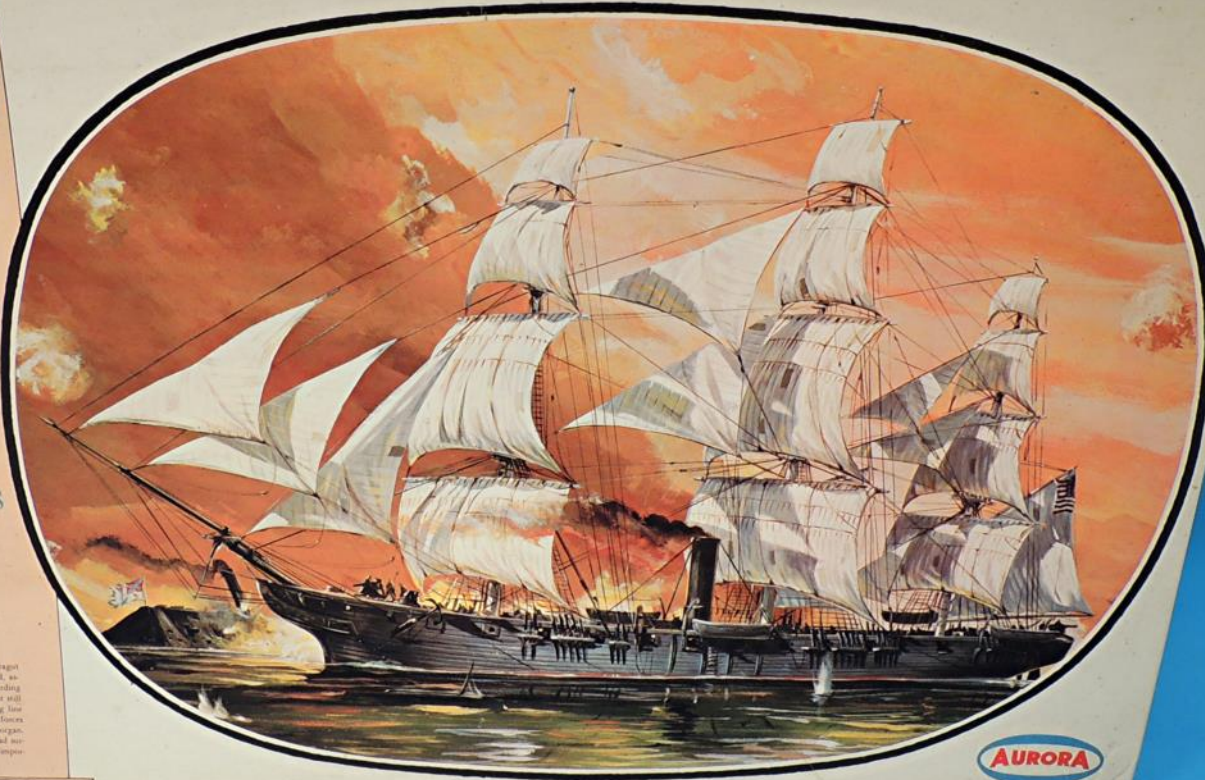

On August 5, 1862, Rear Admiral David Farragut led the Union fleet in his flagship Hartford, assigned to capture Confederate forces guarding Mobile Bay, the only port of the Gulf Coast still under Southern control. Farragut's fighting line sailed past torpedores and mines set by the forces of Confederate Fort Gaines and Fort Morgan. Within the month, both these key bases had surrendered. Farragut had scored one of the important naval victories of the Civil War.
